Special Meeting of April 23, 2019

The Pennington County Board of Commissioners met at 8:15 a.m. on Tuesday, April 23 2019, in the Commission Chambers in the County Administration Building, Rapid City, South Dakota. Chair Deb Hadcock called the meeting to order with the following Commissioners present: Gary Drewes, Lloyd LaCroix and Ron Rossknecht.

**REVIEW AND APPROVE AGENDA**

MOVED by LaCroix and seconded by Rossknecht to approve the agenda as presented. Vote: Unanimous.

**164<sup>TH</sup> AVE BRIDGE, STR. 52-645-305:** MOVED by Drewes and seconded by Rossknecht to declare the collapse of Bridge Str. 52-645-305 as an emergency as a safe alternate access route is not available to at least five local residents. Vote: Unanimous.

MOVED by Drewes and seconded by LaCroix to declare Str. 52-645-305 as surplus for the purpose of disposal. Vote: Unanimous.

DiSanto joined the meeting at 8:30 a.m.

MOVED by LaCroix and seconded by DiSanto to accept the proposal from Corr Construction Services, Inc. to construct a 16'W x 60'L Concrete, Steel Girder Bridge, in the amount of \$157,520, with the addition of Alt. #1, to remove the existing bridge in the amount of \$12,000 for a total of \$169,520, with the addition that Superintendent Joe Miller work with any interested landowners in order to reduce the \$12,000 removal & disposal cost of the old bridge. Vote: Unanimous.
