Description

This is the field deployed version of the FEMA Emergency Management Institute (EMI) MI E273 course. This course is designed to provide an organized training opportunity for local officials responsible for administering their local floodplain management ordinance. The course will focus on the NFIP and concepts of floodplain management, maps and studies, ordinance administration, and the relationship between floodplain management and flood insurance.

Selection Criteria: Local officials responsible for administering local floodplain management ordinances, including but not limited to floodplain management administrators, building inspectors, code enforcement/zoning officers, conservation agents and commissioners, planners, city/county managers, attorneys, engineers, and public works officials. Federal/State/regional floodplain managers also are encouraged to attend. The course is designed for those officials with less than 3 years of floodplain management experience.

Prerequisites:

Prior to the course, participants must complete the:

- FEMA Flood Insurance Rate Map (FIRM) tutorial (30 min).
- FEMA Flood Insurance Studies (FIS) tutorial (40 min).

Resources: Attendees may want to download and review FEMA Publication 480 "<u>Floodplain Management Requirements: A Study Guide and Desk Reference for Local</u> Officials" prior to the course.
