2016 Annual PREA Report

1. CCADP records all allegations of client on client nonconsensual sexual acts to include all reported and substantiated cases. Attempted nonconsensual sexual acts are recorded as well as completed ones. Between July 1, 2016 and December 31, 2016, there were no allegations of client on client nonconsensual sexual acts reports.
2. CCADP records allegations of client on client abusive sexual contact. These are counted separately from allegations of nonconsensual sexual acts. Between July 1, 2016 and December 31, 2016, there were no allegations of client on client abusive sexual contact reported.
3. CCADP records allegations of client on client sexual harassment to include all reported allegations. Between July 1, 2016 and December 31, 2016, there were no allegations of client on client sexual harassment reported.
4. CCADP records allegations of staff sexual misconduct to include all reported occurrences. Between July 1, 2016 and December 31, 2016, there were no allegations of staff sexual misconduct reported.
5. CCADP records allegations of staff sexual harassment. These allegations are counted separately from allegations of staff sexual misconduct. Between July 2, 2016 and December 31, 2016 there were no reported allegations of staff sexual harassment.

Between July 1, 2016 and December 31, 2016, if any allegations would have been reported, a full report would have been provided including type of incident and outcome of the investigation. If the allegations were substantiated or unsubstantiated, this would also be included in the report. Any criminal prosecution or administrative action taken would be outlined in the report. A review of all substantiated sexual abuse allegations would be conducted upon investigation completion. During the review, problem areas would be identified and corrective action, if needed, would be taken.

CCADP Administrative Staff continues to monitor progress and to manage current processes and procedures for detecting, preventing, reducing, and punishing perpetrators of sexual violence. CCADP continues to implement the requirements of the PREA standards and make the necessary changes through on-going review.
