	Open Burning (i.e. burn piles, slash, fires not contained within a fully enclosed fire box or structure, no chimney, duct or stack)	Burn Barrels (metal container with a covered grate) See "Burn Barrel Regulations illustration"	Camp Fires at commercial Camp-grounds (i.e. private only, cannot regulate state or federal)	Branding Iron Burner (i.e. any type of stove furnace device or pit used for branding livestock) *corral, pasture or livestock facility setting	Grills (gas or charcoal) (i.e. used for cooking outdoors)	Fireplace, outdoors (i.e. commercial or homemade that have chimney & screen)

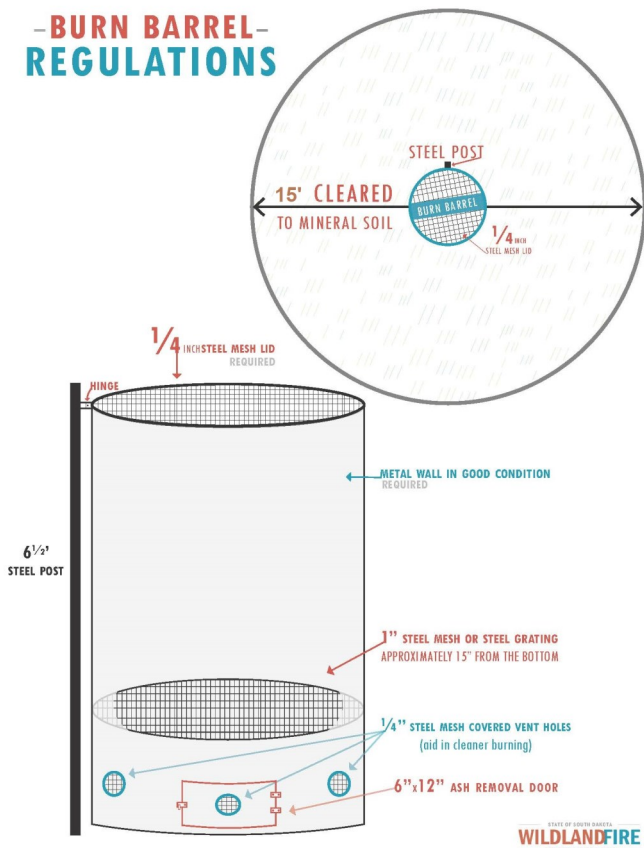

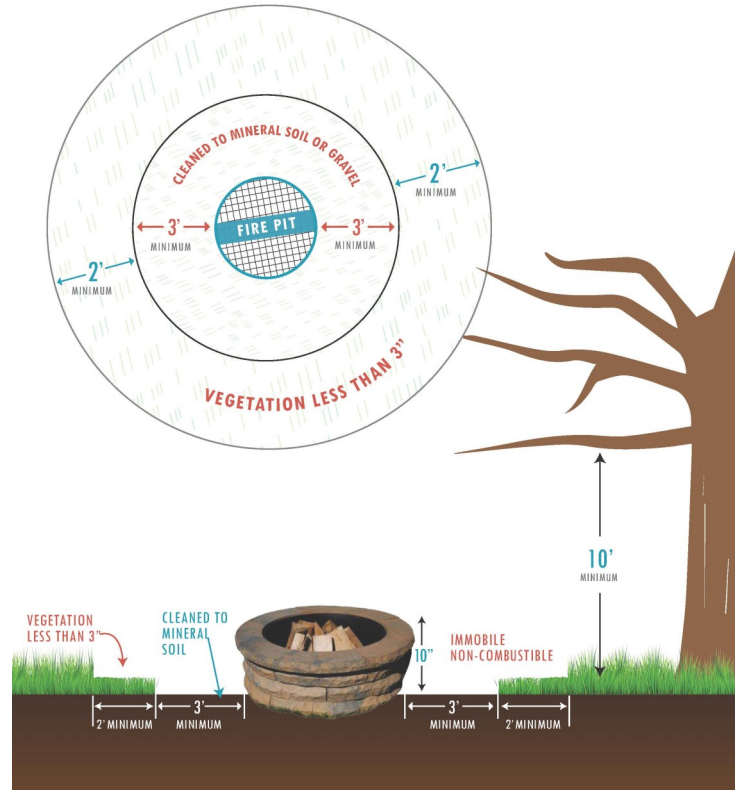
