PENNINGTON COUNTY FIRE SERVICE BOARD MINUTES

Wednesday Nov. 13, 2024 @ 1900 |

The Pennington County Fire Service Board met at 7:00 pm on Wednesday, November 13, 2024, at the Whispering Pines VFD, South Dakota. Chair D. Lindblom called the meeting to order with the following voting board members present: E. Chase, T. Kobes, J. White, D. Harn, C. Maude, T. Deml, B. Povandra, D. Willett

PUBLIC COMMENTS:

- a) Tim Bradeen, fire mitigation contractor, spoke about what he is seeing from the private side of fire mitigation in the Black Hills, as well as through his contracts. He recognized that Black Hills mitigation has been a success story, and we need to keep that going. He encouraged people to review Senate Bill 134 that was built to build up the timber industry. It was passed through the Senate with support but stopped in the House. He discussed the Mountain Pine Beetle epidemic and timber facility production closures. He emphasized that we do not want to lose the ability to cut down trees for mitigation purposes.
- b) D. Lindblom thanked Whispering Pines VFD for the meal.
- c) D. Lindblom, speaking as a rancher, thanked all those who helped with the Mile Marker 66 fire that affected his land.

REVIEW AND APPROVE AGENDA:

MOVED by D. Willett and seconded by B. Povandra to approve the November 13, 2024 Agenda as presented. Vote: Unanimous.

REVIEW AND APPROVE MINUTES:

MOVED by J. White and seconded by T. Deml to approve the September 11, 2024 Minutes as presented. Vote: Unanimous.

REVIEW AND APPROVE FINANCIALS:

MOVED by E. Chase and seconded by C. Maude to accept the financials as presented. Vote: Unanimous.

- a. T. Kobes asked for clarification regarding the negative amounts listed at the bottom of the financials. V. Newman explained the addition of the General Fund 101-0271 Budget information. A separate budget is assigned to help cover Worker Compensation costs. This year the amount was short \$411, and we will be requesting a supplement in that amount at the next BOC meeting. V. Newman also added that this budget information will be added to the bottom of the financials' page moving forward.
- b. T. Kobes asked about the 2025 SDML invoices. V. Newman clarified that these will be sent out Jan. 1. Chiefs were notified of the 2025 estimates amounts earlier this year, and invoices will be sent out Jan. 1. The final billing from SDML did not change from these initial estimates.

- a) 2024 – 2032 Budget – FSB Budget Committee:
 - a. D. Lindblom shared the Budget Committee held a meeting to discuss the Opt Out on Oct. 21, 2024. Additional questions have been identified. The workload will be starting in Jan., with a time frame between Jan. and June. New BOC members will have input regarding the Opt Out.

COMMITTEE REPORTS:

- a) FSB Training – None present
- b) Emergency Management Report – D. Willett explained the Natural Hazard Mitigation Plan is out for final public comment and review. It will then be adopted by Resolution. The Fire Mitigation portion doubles as the CWPP. It is a living document built with GIS, it is virtual and has online interactive capabilities. D. Willett encouraged feedback for this FEMA approved plan. He added State Wildland and other State organizational entities within the County are pushing to adopt the Ready, Set, Go program. They have been able to get one older siren taken down and are looking to replace half of siren next year. Tentatively, the replacement program will take 3-4 years.
 - a. T. Kobes asked if they plan to move any of the sirens. D. Willett stated they will be moving them, prioritizing coverage first to outdoor recreation areas and mobile home complexes next. All sites will be accessible.
- c) Emergency Management Users Board – G. Sortland stated their last meeting was in Oct. and their next meeting is in Jan.
- d) Pennington County Fire Chiefs Association – M. Thompson shared there is currently one certified firefighter course that is ongoing, and two more starting in January. Schedules for the January courses will go out within the week. He reminded everyone that the SD Fire Chief's Leadership Conference is in Deadwood. SD EMS Regional Grant is still pending. The awards should be announced by Friday Nov. 15th. Everyone was reminded about the Alarm Level work session on Dec. 2nd at 5pm in the EOC. There was discussion on changing how they recognize the Lifetime Achievement award so they can award more than one per year. Going forward they will likely be awarding more than one, depending on criteria that is yet to be determined.
- e) Black Hills Fire Advisory Board – B. Povandra stated they met last week. There was discussion about the number of air assets and amounts used this year. The VFA Grant will be out Jan. 1st. They held elections and Jim Strain was voted President, with B. Povandra voted as Vice-Chair. They are seeking higher attendance at their meetings. The 2024 mini-mob guide will be used moving forward after first of year. The next meeting is April 30th in Fairburn.
- f) SD Fire Chiefs Association – B. Povandra reiterated the conference will be held in Deadwood again this year at Cadillac Jacks December 6, 7, 8. This is an opportunity to hear good speakers and for networking. You do not have to be a chief to attend.
- g) Communications – K. Karley shared there is work being completed at Station 1.
- h) County Commission Report – None present

- a) Cascade Update: E. Chase shared the Budget Committee, with the help of Whispering Pines VFD is looking at updating the County Cascade system and the platform to be used. They are just in the beginning stages of the process due to the system being 10 years old. J. Harvey shared it is on the long-term planning schedule.

- a) D. Lindblom state the Reference/How-To binders are due tonight. Please make plans to get yours to the Fire Administration Office soon if you didn't bring yours.
- b) FSB District Representative names are due to V. Newman no later than Nov. 28th, preferably prior to Nov. 22nd.
- c) J. Harvey thanked Julie Frye-Mueller for attending the meeting tonight. He also introduced Josh Trople, Chief for New Underwood Fire. He thanked all departments for helping with their restructuring and reaching out to him and his officers to assist.
- d) J. Harvey offered a detailed update and overview of the Fire Administration Office covering meetings, events, response guides, road construction updates, BOC topics, on-going projects, operation highlights, and other items of importance and interest.
 - a. The Alarm Level meeting on Dec. 2nd will start at 5:00 pm in the EOC. M. Shoemaker, ESCC Tech Director, will be explaining the new alarm level sheets and everyone will be working together to update their alarm levels. PennCo VFD Chief, Assistant Chief(s), and/or a designee must be present for this work session. Personnel attending must be empowered to make decisions for your agency.
 - b. He reminded everyone to make sure you are reviewing the Weekly Update. It doesn't take very long to read through and there is a lot of vital information being shared from this platform. This way of communicating prevents you being slammed with emails throughout the week. New items are at the top, reminder items for reference are next, then Calendar events and trainings, and Job postings.
 - c. Make sure to contact our office as soon as you know there is an injury either via phone, text or email. Per our directives, all work-related injuries must be reported to the HR Risk Manager within 24 hours and sent to Claims Associates within 72 hours. We are here to help assist you with any documents and/or any questions you may have. Refer to the Reference/How-To for all related documents.
- e) P. Schlieff added there is a public meeting for Phase 2 of the US Hwy 385 construction project on Thurs., Nov. 21st. Information can be found on the Events & Training Calendar.



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- f) D. Willett shared local response, and relationships will be coming back with the Red Cross. Jaimi Mueller is the Community Disaster Program Manager for Central and Western South Dakota. They had an organization restructuring that brought a loss of local connections, focusing on a regional concept. They are still struggling with volunteers and funding.
- g) V. Newman asked all present to turn in their annual 2025 SDML updates, review for accuracy on the Chiefs/Assistant Chief list, RSVP for the Alarm Level meeting, and confirm their department's participation on the Fire Assistant Team for 2025.
